B. Give the phonetic symbol for each of the following sounds:

1. a glottal stop
2. a voiceless labiodental fricative
3. a voiced interdental fricative
4. a mid front lax vowel
5. a low back round vowel
6. a high back unround lax vowel (hint: it's more often an allophone than a separate phoneme)
7. a high front tense vowel
8. a high back round tense vowel
